- The municipality will deposit one day's salary of public representatives and employees into the disaster fund.
- An interaction program will be held with other municipalities regarding Making City Resilient MCR 2030.
- The municipality will develop a plan for implementing local disaster and climate resilience plans.
- Schools will be made into learning centers for disaster and climate management.
- The municipality will develop a green Belauri Municipality by conserving ponds, lakes, irrigation and deep wells.
- The municipality will develop a green Belauri Municipality by conserving ponds, lakes, and deep wells.
- The 5th Kanchanpur Conference 2082 of the Uplifting Municipal Forum will be organized for safe and sustainable development.
- The necessary manpower and materials will be managed at the disaster warehouse and local emergency operations center.
- The process of purchasing a fire engine has progressed in collaboration with Belauri Municipal Corporation and Laljhadi Rural Municipality. Funds have also been arranged for this purpose.
- All sectors, including the private sector, will incorporate risk-informed disaster and climate risk management plans into their sectoral plans.
- Emphasis will be placed on spreading widespread public awareness about disaster management.
- The municipality will prioritize pollution control, waste management, and promotion of greenery to ensure the citizens' right to live in a clean and healthy environment.
- An information mechanism will be created for disaster management preparedness.
- Work will be done in the area of pre-preparedness in collaboration with organizations working in disaster areas.
- Food items will be provided to the disavantage of the poor families.
- A disaster home insurance program will be implemented in Wards 2, 5, 6, 8, and 10.
- Solid waste management will be carried out in coordination with the Belauri Municipality's Punarbas Municipality and Laljhadi Rural Municipality.
